- The game for:**
- teams who want to get to know one another better and integrate
 - real adventure seekers and aficionados of the history of the Middle Ages
 - companies who want their employees to experience being dependent on their team
 - people who want to experience something exceptional within the team, develop strategic thinking and making right decisions

- Challenge:**
- You will adopt the roles of royal legates who visit the castles of the Krakow-Częstochowa Upland. You will discover places where the fates of the castles and their residents intertwine. On your way, like the heroes of books and films, you will solve riddles, perform physical tasks and find clues. Your task will be to find control stations, gather as many points as possible, be on time in a given place and first and foremost find what has been lost while driving your own car.

- Foundation:**
- norms of communication in a team
 - delegation of tasks
 - managing a small team

- Logistics:**
- each team gets one car to drive from point to point along a designated route
 - at least one person in a team must have a driving license

- the game is dedicated to the Krakow-Częstochowa Upland and its castles

- Advantages:**
- training your observation, agility and logical thinking
 - deep integration of the team
 - getting to know what team roles are in practice and what improper division of tasks in the team may result in
 - experiencing team management in unusual situations in practice
 - experiencing an emotional adventure among picturesque landscapes of the Krakow-Częstochowa Upland

- Variants / Extensions:**
- depending on the customer requirements, the game can take more or less time
 - the game can be complemented by the training session in crisis management
 - the expedition can be an excellent form of the on-boarding workshop
